Effective November 27<sup>th</sup> new measures have been put into place by the Government of Saskatchewan to help reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19. Starting Friday, November 27<sup>th</sup> mandatory, non-medical masking will be required of all students, employees and visitors in all schools (except while consuming food or beverage or engaging in aquatic fitness activities). Children ages 0-2 years are exempt from wearing masks. Students and staff are required to wear masks while at school in all indoor school spaces, when physical distancing is not possible outside, and during bus transportation.

We continue to have all students safety as a focus. We have had success with protocols and procedures that are in place to help make our school a safe place to learn. This is one more measure that will enhance the safety of our students and staff.
